**The Brade Bunch:** The late-renaissance/early baroque composer William Brade composed a number of fabulous dances and was the first Englishman (turned German) to compose a canzona, a form already very popular in Italy. We'll play a bunch of his dances and canzonas!

In addition to teaching private lessons, Jennifer has been on the faculty of a number of early music workshops throughout the United States.
