The November program is playing a wide variety of arrangements from Patti Grandel from Colorado Springs who has done dozens of arrangements for the WoodDove recorder ensemble. We will be looking at arrangements of tunes by Byrd, Hassler, Telemann, Beethoven, Vaughan Williams, Loeillet, Gibbons, Sousa and John Williams.

Patti Grandel is originally from Pittsburgh, PA. She received her BA of Fine Arts in Music Performance (flute & piccolo) from Carnegie Mellon University, along with her music teaching certificate. She performed in several Pittsburgh area orchestras before moving to Colorado Springs in 1971.

Patti has performed in nearly every musical organization in the Springs both as an instrumentalist and a singer. These include the CSSO, Chamber Orchestra of the Springs (founding member), Pikes Peak Opera Theater, Opera Theater of the Rockies, Colorado Springs Chorale, Colorado Vocal Arts Ensemble, Fine Arts Center Music Theater, Glen Eyre Madrigal, among many others.

Patti began arranging the music she needed, and it has become an obsession! Patti now plays Sopranino through bass recorders. which has added to her understanding of arranging for various recorder groupings.
